The Southwest Office of Native American Programs is pleased to inform you that the Indian Housing Plan (IHP) you submitted on July 6, 2015, for Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2016 funding under the Indian Housing Block Grant program has been found in compliance with the requirements of Section 102 of the Native American Housing Assistance and Self Determination Act of 1996 (NAHASDA) and the associated requirements at 24 CFR Part 1000

The regulation at 24 CFR 1000.214 explains that grant funds will be provided to a recipient when two conditions are met: (1) the IHP is found in compliance with section 102 of NAHASDA and (2) funds are available. As stated above, the first condition has been met (your IHP is in compliance). Unfortunately, at the present time, grant funds for FFY 2016 are not yet available.

We will notify you as soon as funds become available. The final grant amount you receive may be different from the amount estimated in your IHP. However, you will not need to submit a revised IHP unless: (1) the funds you have already allocated to maintain 1937 Housing Act units are reduced; or (2) you wish to add a new activity.
